Abnormal behavior is defined as behavior that is deviant, maladaptive, and/or personally distressful • Distress: The individual reports of great personal distress o The distressed created by obsessive behavior drives a person wash her hands 4 times an hour, take 7 showers a day, and cleans her apartment twice
