State and local spending on police protection In nominal (not infation-adjusted) dollars, state and local police-protection spending per capita was \$35154 in 2017 (table 3) The portion of state and local direct general expenditures that were devoted to police protection fell 13% from 2000 to 2017 (from 378% to 373%) (based on table 1)
