The table saw blade needs to be set to the stave edge angle I use an inexpensive digital angle gauge with a readout in tenths of a degree For material over 1/4 inch thick accuracy becomes important If the angle is not correct when the unit is assembled the multiple joints will be tight or loose I find that over cut angles (looser) work better

WOODWORKING TOOLS, MATERIALS, AND METHODS

A tilt-arbor table bench saw (figure 3-2) is so named because the saw blade can be tilted for cutting bevels by tilting the arbor The arbor, located beneath the table, is controlled by the tilt handwheel In earlier types of bench saws, the saw blade remained stationary and the table was tilted A canted (tilted) saw table is hazardous in many

Extension-table leaves, when used on a leg-and-apron table, can be kept flat by continuing the aprons below the leaf Again, use an anchoring screw at the cen-ter and slotted holes on either side Also, make the extension apron a bit shorter mortise-and-tenon joint Each end of the tabletop is tenoned, while a mortise is cut into the breadboard
