answers Objective Information-Seeking Tweet: The intent of an objective information-seeking tweet is to receive answers based on some factual knowledge or common experiences The purpose of an objective question is to receive one or more correct answers, instead of responses based on the answerer's personal experience

Developing Objectives and Relating them to Assessment
