Compost tea is the product of "brewing" precise portions of: --High-quality compost, --Microbe foods, --Water (de-chlorinated and room temperature), and --Aeration (vigorous) --Time (usually 24 hours, but depends on the make of brewer) Hence the more proper name, Actively Aerated Compost Tea What is "Brewing"?
