The Jazz Waltz Bill Evans transformed the jazz waltz creating the standard which is still in use today by composers and performers His use of a two feel and a four against three feel along with his impressionistic voicings, produced what is now a standard jazz waltz feel Of course much of this can be linked to Chopin and Ravel demonstrating
